Articles: A, An, The

- ❖ We use **a** before nouns that begin with **consonant sounds**. E.g a book , a pen.
- ❖ We use **an** before singular countable nouns that begin with **vowel sounds**. E.g an ant, an orange, an inkpot, an umbrella.
- Some words beginning with **H** such as hour, honest etc., begin with a **vowel sound** as **H** is silent. Hence we say **an** honest man, **an** hour.
- Words like university, union, European, etc., begin with a **consonant sound (yu)** .Therefore, we say **a** European, **a** University.

Usage of articles a, an the

- ❖ We use the articles **a** and **an** when we talk about any person, place, animal or thing. E.g My sister wants a watch and an umbrella. (any watch , any umbrella)
- ❖ We use the article **the** when we wish to talk about a specific person, place, animal or thing. E.gThe watch that my sister bought for me is nice. (some specific watch)
- ❖ We also use the article **the** in the following cases.

- Before the things that are one of a kind. E.g the Earth , the Sun, the planets.
- Before the proper nouns denoting monuments, rivers, seas etc. e.g the Taj Mahal, the Ganga, the

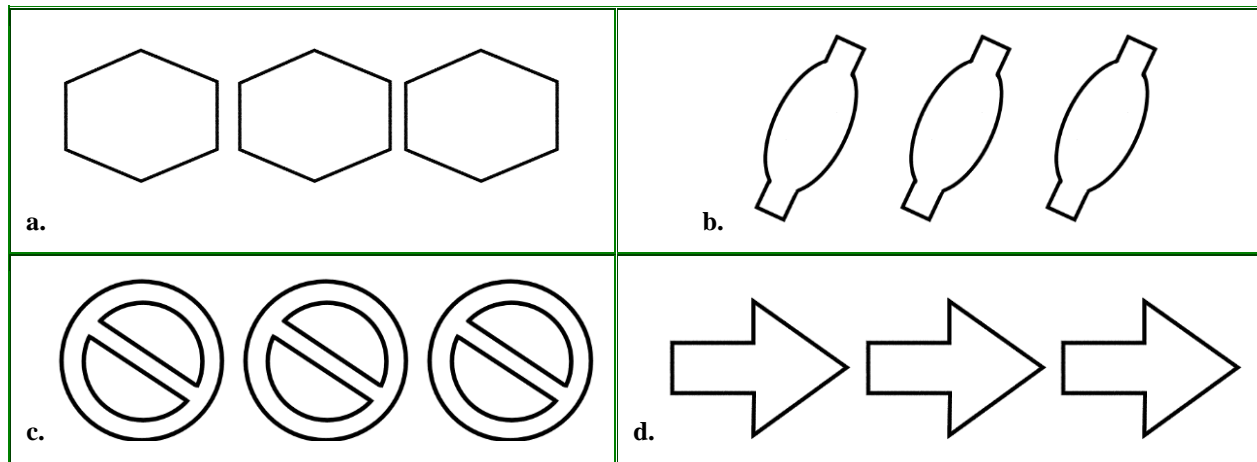

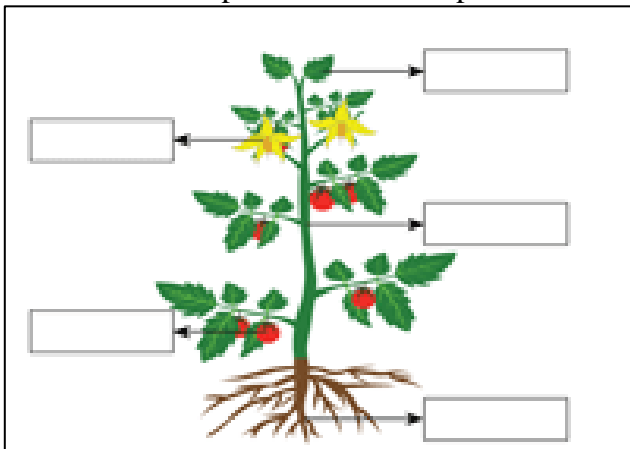
