Articles: A, An, The

- ❖ We use <u>a</u> before nouns that begin with <u>consonant sounds</u>. E.g a book, a pen.
- ❖ We use <u>an</u> before singular countable nouns that begin with <u>vowel sounds</u>. E.g an ant, an orange, an inkpot, an umbrella.
- Some words beginning with $\underline{\mathbf{H}}$ such as hour, honest etc., begin with a **vowel sound** as $\underline{\mathbf{H}}$ is silent. Hence we say **an** honest man, **an** hour.
- Words like university, union, European, etc., begin with a **consonant sound (yu)**. Therefore, we say a European, a University.


Usage of articles a, an the

- ❖ We use the articles **a** and **an** when we talk about any person, place, animal or thing. E.g My sister wants a watch and an umbrella. (any watch, any umbrella)
- We use the article **the** when we wish to talk about a specific person, place, animal or thing. E.gThe watch that my sister bought for me is nice. (some specific watch)
- ❖ We also use the article **the** in the following cases.




